

**Authorized Projects  
Tuscaloosa Area MPO  
Fiscal Year 2007**

The federal regulations require Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPO) to publish a list of projects that were authorized in the previous fiscal year and involved federal highway or transit funds. The table includes projects from the Tuscaloosa Area funded in fiscal year 2007, which ran from October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007. A project is considered authorized when a funding contract has been completed.

Regarding the format of the following table, the project number refers to the ALDOT's project management number. The description is a basic definition of the project. The scope is an abbreviation of the phase of the project. In general most projects are divided into preliminary engineering, right-of-way purchase, utility relocation, and construction.

The type of work provides a general explanation of the work performed. The cost figures are the total cost for that particular phase. The sponsor is the government or agency that provides the local match for the federal funds. The match on all of the authorized projects was 20%. The bike/ped. element indicates if the project included any bicycle and/or pedestrian facilities. The program is the federal funding category used to undertake the project.
