WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa Area MPO is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by the FAST Act, Sections 1201 and 1202, December 2015); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa Area MPO adopted the *FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program* (TIP) in 2019; and

WHEREAS, in order to be eligible for federal funding, transportation projects are required to be in the TIP; and

- 3. **(Addition)** 100073299 Intersection Improvements at SR-215 (15th St) and 2nd Ave, including adding a right turn lane on SR-215, extending the existing left turn lane on SR-215, signal upgrades and adding a 10-ft shared use path along SR-215; CN; 12/2/2022; \$753,687
- 4. **(Addition)** 100073531 Sec. 5310 Transit Eagles' Wings (Urban) Capital Rolling Stock (1 CCB) FY-2020; 5/1/2021; \$61,102
